

2018 SCHOLARSHIP AUDITIONS

MONDAY MUSICAL CLUB OF PORTLAND is pleased to announce its year 2018 scholarship auditions. Cash prizes will be awarded to the most outstanding participants. Please read the following information carefully.

Auditions will be held on Saturday, April 21, 2018, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Holladay Park Plaza, 1300 NE 16^a Ave., Portland.

Competition is open to students studying music in the State of Oregon who are full-time students in a state-accredited high school or college. (Home school is acceptable for high school.)

Categories are piano, strings, wind & brass instruments for ages 16-22; voice for ages 18-25.

Contestants may apply to audition in only one category. Previous scholarship winners must wait a period of four years before reapplying.

REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Contestants are required to perform two pieces in contrasting styles and from two different musical period classifications, as indicated on the application form. Ignoring this requirement (such as performing two numbers from the same category) will bring deductions. Arrangements from original composers' work are discouraged. Two languages (including English) are recommended for singers.
- B. Each contestant is limited to a total of nine minutes performing time. Each selection should be performed in its entirety (without cuts, but repeats are not required). A copy of music is required for the adjudicator; photocopies will not be accepted.
- C. Contestants must furnish their own accompanists. Taped accompaniments will not be permitted.
- D. Nonrefundable fee is \$25. Please make a check payable to Monday Musical Club.
- E. The application form must be completed and received no later than March 31, 2018. Accepted applicants will receive notification after the deadline. We urge the form be returned well before the deadline because we may have to limit the number of applicants.
- F. Winners will be presented in performance at the Monday Musical Club Scholarship Tea at 1:00 p.m. on May 7, 2018, at Holladay Park Plaza, 1300 NE 16th Avenue, Portland.
