

YESTERYEAR.... Notes from Monday Musical History




Those of you who've joined MMC in the last few years may have wondered why we have a music award in honor of Jess Foster. Well, here's the story.

The Jess Foster Vocal Award was created by Jim and Mary Foster, son and daughter-in-law of Jesse Foster who directed the MMC chorus for many years, well into his 90's, and was one of the leading music educators in Portland.

Jess taught at both Roosevelt and Lincoln High schools in Portland and became Assistant Supervisor of Music for Portland Schools. In addition, he served over the years as choir director of a number of Portland churches and directed high school choruses. Many Monday Musical members were members of his high school choruses. He and his wife were devoted to MMC and their family wanted to memorialize their parents by establishing a Monday Musical Award in his name.
