I KNOW THERE ARE TALENTED PEOPLE OUT THERE WHO ARE PERFECTLY CAPABLE OF BRINGING THIS TOGETHER, SO I AM ASKING FOR YOUR HELP. CALL ME OR ANY OTHER MEMBER OF THE BOARD TO OFFER YOUR TALENT, TIME, AND ADVICE."...

AN IMPORTANT SUBJECT CONT'D

IN ADDITION, WE HAVE A NEED FOR PEOPLE TO STEP UP INTO OTHER ROLES AT MMC. WHEN THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE MET IN APRIL 2025, THEY WORKED DILIGENTLY TO FIND CANDIDATES TO FILL BOARD POSITIONS FOR 2025 2026. THEY ONLY PARTIALLY SUCCEEDED, DUE TO THE LACK OF VOLUNTEERS. AS THE NEW PRESIDENT, I HAVE REACHED OUT FOR HELP, HAVE SUGGESTED THAT PERHAPS WE COULD DO SOMETHING CALLED JOB-SHARING BUT HAVE RECEIVED NO VOLUNTEERS. THEREFORE, YOUR BOARD HAS BEEN FUNCTIONING WITH A LIMITED NUMBER OF MEMBERS WHO ARE ALL DOING SEVERAL JOBS TO KEEP MMC GOING. THIS SITUATION CANNOT LAST AS OUR MEMBERSHIP NUMBER HAS DECLINED, AND WE ARE ALL GETTING OLDER. AS YOU WILL SEE BELOW, WE WILL BE WORKING ON HOW TO REBUILD THE MEMBERSHIP IN THE COMING MONTHS AND WILL NEED YOUR HELP AND SUPPORT.

YOUR BOARD OF MANAGEMENT IS WORKING ON AN OUTREACH PROGRAM WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF PROFESSIONALS. WE ARE CONSIDERING ENGAGING WITH SOMEONE WHO CAN HELP US EXPAND OUR MEMBERSHIP THROUGH MULTIPLE CHANNELS WITH THE EXPECTATION THAT WE COULD ACQUIRE NEW MEMBERS WHO ARE WILLING TO BRING THEIR ENERGY AND PERSPECTIVE TO MMC AS WE LOOK TO THE FUTURE.
